



## Foundation Subjects:

As Historians we will begin the year by looking at the history of Woburn. As we move further towards Winter we will be researching famous explorers such as Scott of the Antarctic.

As Geographers we will be looking at Woburn and the surrounding area. We will follow this by looking at the Arctic and Antarctic, Inuit life and discussing the ecological issues currently facing these parts of the world.

As Artists we will be looking at Inuit art and producing our own versions. We will also create Christmas crafts.

Our focus in Computing will be E-Safety and using programmes such as 2Graph and 2Paint. We will use ICT to present and enhance our work from other curriculum areas.

## Mathematics:

As Mathematicians we will be working with numbers to 50 and beyond. We will be focusing on number ordering and addition & subtraction. Year 2 will begin their work on times tables and Year 1 will focus on number bonds to 10. We will also look at coinage, time, shapes and measures in both standard and non-standard units.

## Science:

As Scientists we will be investigating Seasonal Changes, where we will visit the school allotment to compare the differences between Autumn and Winter. We will also spend some time looking at Animals and Humans.

## English:

We will continue our work on the Talk4Writing scheme. The year will begin with work on setting descriptions using the book “Ruby Nettle and the Ice Lolly Adventure” for inspiration. Further into the term we will start looking at non-chronological reports and using the stories “Ice Bear” by Nicola Davies and “The Polar Bears Home” by Lara Bergen. Nearer Christmas our focus will turn to Winter & Christmas poetry.

To help us write our own stories and factual reports, we will work on grammar, handwriting and phonics.

## Spiritual & Moral:

As part of our spiritual and moral development we will continue to build our knowledge about different faiths and beliefs through RE lessons, class discussions and assemblies. The children will have regular circle time and PSHE sessions.
