

# Dinosaurs

## Foundation Subjects:

As Historians we will be researching dinosaurs and fossils. We will look at great fossil hunters such as Mary Anning.

As Geographers we will be looking at important dinosaur discoveries in the UK and finding out why these fossils were found in these places.

As Artists our focus will be on pattern making by looking at the images on fossils.

Our focus in Computing will be an introduction to programming using Beebots and 2Go. We will use ICT to present and enhance our work from other curriculum areas.



## English:

We shall be continuing to develop our English skills using the techniques taught in the Talk4Writing scheme.

As authors we will be looking at the stories “Captain Finn & The Pirate Dinosaur” by Giles Andreae and “Dear Dinosaur” by Chae Strathie and Nicola O’Byrne. We will also look at real life accounts of dinosaur finds.

To help us write our own stories and factual reports, we will work on grammar, handwriting and phonics.

## Mathematics:

As mathematicians we will be working with numbers to 50 and beyond. We will be focusing on number ordering and addition & subtraction. Year 2 will continue their work on times tables and Year 1 will focus on coin recognition and number bonds to 20. We will also look at fractions, time, shapes and measures in both standard and non-standard units.

## Science:

As scientists we will be using our scientific skills learnt this year so far to investigate Dinosaurs. We will also spend some time looking at Plants and what they need to grow and flourish.

## Spiritual & Moral:

As part of our spiritual and moral development we will continue to build our knowledge about different faiths and beliefs through RE lessons, class discussions and assemblies. The children will look at the Jigsaw scheme of work “Dreams & Goals” in PSHE..
