The Great Outdoors!

Foundation Subjects:

As historians we will be finding out about the history of insect life. We will also look at bread making and bread from earliest times to the modern day.

As geographers we will look at the places insects can be found and how these fascinating creatures have adapted to their environment.

As artists we will be producing our own studies of plants and focusing on using watercolours as a medium.

Our focus in Computing will be using technology to create, store and retrieve data. We will be using 2Animate to produce our own films about the life cycle of a butterfly. We will use 9CT to present and enhance our work from other curriculum areas.



English:

Continuing with Talk4 Writing, we will begin by looking at non-chronological reports about insects. During the second half of the term we will look at the story "The Green Ship", by Quentin Blake and thinking about writing our own adventure stories.

To help us write our own stories and factual reports, we will work on grammar, handwriting and phonics.

Mathematics:

As mathematicians we will be working with numbers to 50 and beyond. We will be focusing on number ordering, addition, subtraction multiplication and division. Year 2 will continue their work on times tables and will continue work on fractions. We will also look at 3D shapes, coinage, time and capacity.

Science:

As scientists we will be looking at living things and their habitats in the first half term and plants during the second half term.

We will be observing our own cress plants and looking at how they grow.

Spiritual & Moral:

As part of our spiritual and moral development we will explore feelings during PSHE and circle time and continue to build our knowledge about faith and beliefs through class discussions and assemblies.

RE focus for this term will be places that are
