

RAINFOREST

Foundation Subjects:

As Geographers we will be looking at the location of the rainforests, their geographical make-up, the animals that can be found there and the threats facing these areas of natural beauty.

As Artists and Designers our focus will be on the work of Rousseau, creating moving models using K-Nex and designing leaf prints.

Our focus in Computing will be using photographic images to make art work in the style of Rousseau. We will use ICT to present and enhance our work from other curriculum areas.



Mathematics:

As mathematicians we will be working with numbers to 50 and beyond. We will be focusing on number ordering, addition & subtraction and multiplication and division. Year 2 will continue their work on times tables and telling the time and Year 1 will focus on counting in steps of 2, 5 and 10 and telling the time. We will also look at fractions, time, shapes and measures in both standard and non-standard units.

Science:

As scientists we will be investigating common materials such as wood, metal and plastic. We will continue our observations and work on seasonal change.

English:

As authors we will be looking at the story “The Great Kapok Tree”, using our Talk4Writing techniques.

To help us write our own pieces of suspense and persuasive writing, we will work on grammar, handwriting and phonics.

We will continue to work on reading skills including decoding of words and comprehension.

Spiritual & Moral:

As part of our spiritual and moral development we will continue to build our knowledge about different faiths and beliefs through RE lessons, class discussions and assemblies.

We will investigate the ecological implications of deforestation.
